0. Start an Internet Explorer browser (any version you have)
1. Access <http://avrams.ro>



Type a valid email address you want use as username for access to these resources in the *username* field.
Type your First Name in the *First Name* text box.

Re-Type the password you wat use for this account in in the *Verify/Retype Password* text box. The passwords must be the same.
Press the *Verify* button to check your passwords. If the username and password you type are compliant to the rules the *Verify* button changes in *Submit* button. Press *Submit* button to send your account data to the server.

4. Fill in the boxes:
 - Username: an email address you want use later on for access or to be contacted;
 - First Name: Your real First Name;
 - LastName: Your actual Last Name (as registered to the Faculty) ;
 - Password: type a character string having 5 or more character as a password;
 - Verify/Retype Password: retype the same string you type previously;




